

**MINUTES OF THE INTERDENOMINATIONAL CHURCH JKUAT ANNUAL
GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 2ND MARCH 2025 AT SCC 100 FROM 1254 HRS
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Introduction

The IDC-JKUAT Annual General Meeting was held on March 2, 2025, at SCC 100, chaired by the Church Chairperson - Elder Aggrey Wanyama. The meeting covered key agenda items including pastorate, chairman's and finance reports & budgetary roadmap for 2025, and elections of elders and deacons.

Attendance: 105 members present, 11 absent with apology

Minutes and Matters arising from the AGM held in 2024

The minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 3rd March 2024 were read and confirmed as true records of the proceedings as Proposed by Elder Anna Indeché and seconded by Mr. James Muguta. Members were then taken through the matters arising from those minutes.

Pastorate Report

2024 Reflection: The theme "Evident Allegiance to God" saw 13 baptisms and 20 child dedications. Notable leadership changes included Pastor Daniel Oluoch joining as Youth Pastor and Rev. Martin Muchoki joining the pastoral team.

2025 Vision: The new theme is "Believe and See God's Glory" (John 11:40), focusing on divine intervention and recognizing God's work.

Church Chairperson's Report

The Church Chairperson's report covered the issues from the ministries & Fellowships. It included the reports from all the committees, fellowships and bible study groups in the church covering aspects like membership, activities held in 2024, emerging issues, challenges and recommendations.

Financial Report & 2025 Budget

2024 Financials: The church collected KES 4,911,986, exceeding the projected KES 4.5 million. Total expenditure was KES 3,704,440.

2025 Budget: A total budget of KES 5,252,583 was approved. Major allocations include Missions (KES 450,000) and Sunday School (KES 300,000).

Key Projects: The church is in initial stages of collaborating with the Chaplaincy for a dedicated Chapel space and planning capital-intensive equipment upgrades.
